Consider requested amendments to the <i>FYs 2008 - 2011 Transportation Improvement Program</i>	

CAMPO staff solicited requests for amendments to the *CAMPO FYs 2008 – 2011 Transportation Improvement Program* in June and July. The requested amendments are shown in **Table 1**. **Table 2** depicts the amendments CAMPO is addressing administratively

The requested amendments were the subject of the September 8<sup>th</sup> Public Hearing (no one commented at the Public Hearing) and were also presented at four community meetings for public review and comment:

\*The community meetings began with an Open House from 6:00 p.m. - 6:30 p.m. Staff was available to present the requested amendments after the Open House and for questions and answers following the presentation.

Public comments on the requests were accepted via an on-line survey ([www.campotexas.org](http://www.campotexas.org)), email, fax or letter until September 12, 2008. No comments were received by fax or letter. Thirty-two (32) on-line responses were received. Of these, 22% (7) supported all of the proposed amendments. 78% (25) were against some or all of the proposed amendments.

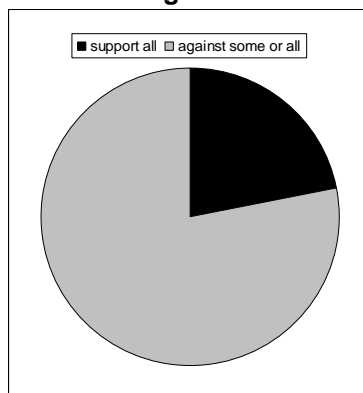
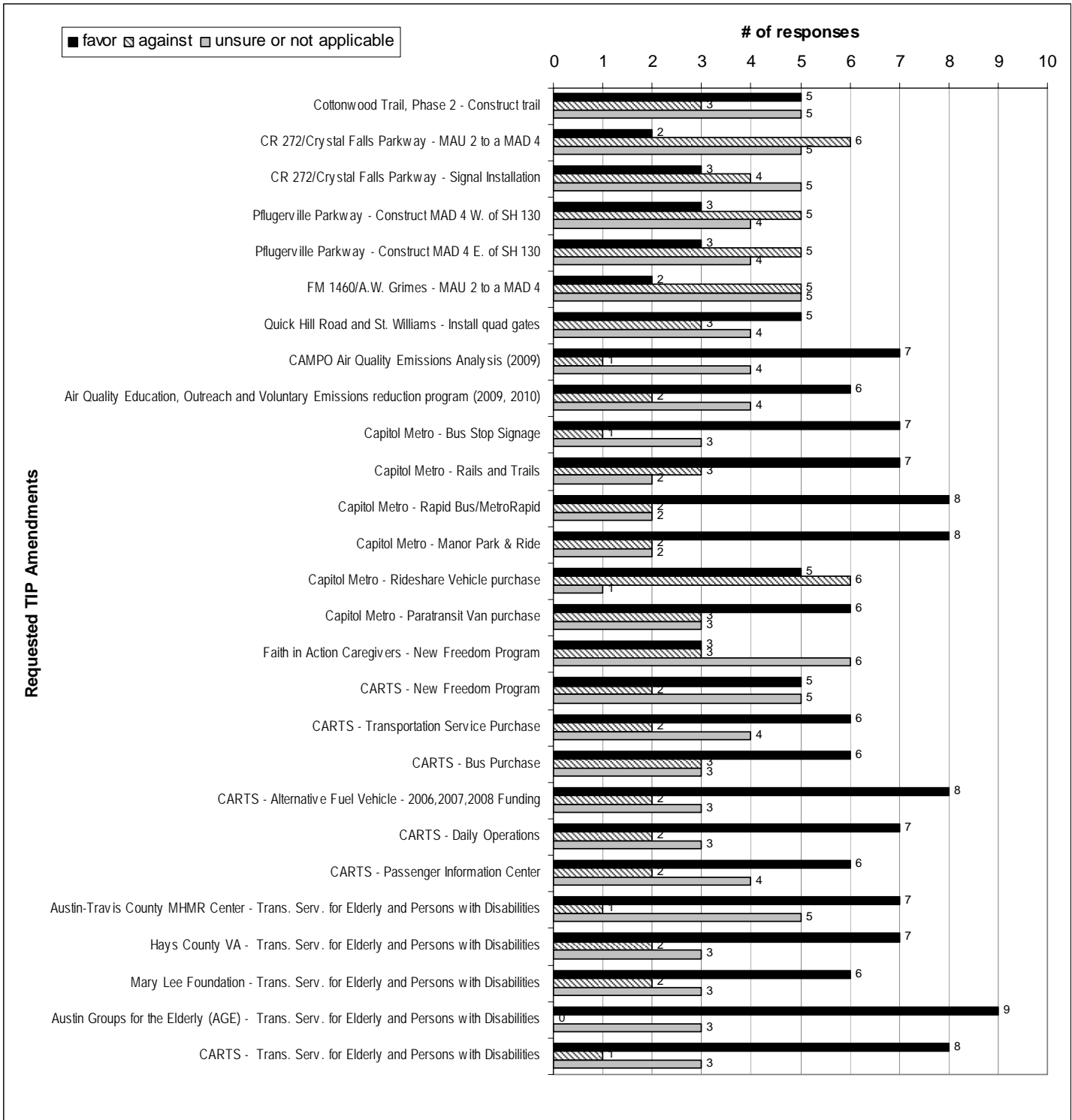
